#### **Practice Area**

Did you know we have a defined practice area? This area has been agreed with NHS England and reflects a contractual obligation for us to provide full medical services to those patients registered with the practice who live within that area. It is particularly important that patients are aware of this as our community nurses will only visit housebound patients within that defined area.

When patients are young, fit and healthy, living a little way outside the area is usually not an issue as they can get to the practice and they do not need the input of the community nursing team. However, when patients become more frail or are in need of home visits, we are not resourced to provide this service and we encourage patients to register closer to their home so that they can access the full range of services they may need. We would encourage anyone moving outside of the main catchment area of Hexham to check with us as our inability to visit at a critical time can cause issues.
